Born on August 25, 1918 in Massachu setts, Lenny's parents were not musicians, but his musical abilities were discovered when he was 10, when he first encountered a piano. He entered Harvard University at 17 and went on to attend the Curtis [nstitute

of Music.

At 21, he attended the Tanglewood Music Festival. His experiences there informed his vision for PMF. \

In 1943, a very famous conductor of the New York Phil fell ill at the last minute, and Assistant Conductor Lenny suddenly had his public debut. The concert was a huge success, and from that night he embarked on his brilliant, multi-faceted Cateer. In the Fall of 1989, Sapporo, Japan, with its mild summer climate. was chosen as the site of an educational music festival.



PMF began in 1990. Lenny conducted Schumann's 2nd symphony, and in spite of his poor health, his passionate instruction deeply inspired the young musicians

of the PMF Orchestra.

Lenny returned to the USA looking forward to the next PMF. But in October of that year, he passed away. "My decision has been to spend most of the remaining energy and time the Lord grants me with education, Sharing as much as possible with Younger people."

Every summer since Lenny's passing, PMF has carried on his vision.
